



# 2019 PETIT VERDOT

**APPELLATION:**

Walla Walla Valley

**VINEYARDS:**

McClellan Estate Vineyard

**TECHNICAL NOTES:**

pH 3.80  
TA 0.57 g/100mL  
Alcohol 14.6% By Volume

**FERMENTATION:**

Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing, the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

**AGING:**

21 months in French oak barrels, 60% new

**CASES PRODUCED:**

190 cases

**SENSORY NOTES:**

Only one word is needed to describe this unique wine...delicious! This deep purple wine opens with aromas of black cherry, boysenberry, and blackberry along with notes of cocoa powder, clove, tobacco, and vanilla. The flavors are concentrated with red and blue fruits that seem perfectly ripe. Excellent mouthfeel with generous round tannins and a long, lingering finish. There is not much Petit Verdot planted in the Walla Walla Valley, making this a rare find. Enjoy!
