times per day by hand until the wine completed primary fermentation. The young wine was transferred to a French oak puncheon to complete

malolactic fermentation.

Bravissimo! Nebbiolo is a rare find in the Walla Walla Valley, and famous in the Piedmont region of Northwest Italy. As you pour this stunning wine, you'll be captivated by its classic garnet hue, a prelude to the sensory journey that lies ahead. The bouquet is a delightful tapestry of spicy cherry, raspberry, and cranberry, intertwined with notes of rose

petal, clove, nutmeg, and herbs that invite you to take a deeper breath.

On the palate, this Nebbiolo reveals its true elegance, featuring silky tannins and a vibrant medley of ripe cherry, wild strawberry, and red raspberry flavors that dance harmoniously together. The finish is silky,

long, and generous, leaving you yearning for another sip.
